




Dear Zoo

The flap book 'Dear Zoo' encouraged the children to name and describe zoo animals. During Whole School singing sessions the children learnt and performed a number of wild animal songs and rhymes. Many children were be found singing these songs later on when playing in the nursery.





World Book Day

On World Book Day an area of the setting was transformed into a cosy, comfortable reading area. Parents were invited to come in and share their favourite stories and the children drunk hot chocolate. The theme this year was 'Elmer' the colourful elephant. Everyone was encouraged to come to school in colourful clothes.

Traditional Tales

The children read traditional tales and showed their understanding of the story by helping adults to retell the repeated refrains using puppets and by mark making on story maps. Reading these familiar traditional tales helps children to develop story comprehension as they talk about the characters as well as an awareness of story structure.

Bear Hunt

The children have enjoyed the well-known story 'Going on a Bear Hunt' by Michael Rosen. The classic story with its strong rhythm is one which the children have enjoyed retelling with adult support as well as in role play. 
