

'Celebrating and Strengthening our Communities Together'

Our learning this half-term....

First we focused on a rhyming story to settle us back into Nursery School. The children explored the classic story 'Each Peach Pear Plum'. We tried plums and pears and voted which one was our favourite. We did this through a role play picnic in 💄 our group time.





Our learning then progressed onto looking carefully out our environment and landscape to spot the signs of winter. The children thoroughly enjoyed looking around the icy garden and noticed changes to our garden trees. We read the story 'Gruffalo's Child' to build on our previous knowledge of the Gruffalo. This story is set in a winter landscape and helped the children observe seasonal changes through visual story pictures too. We practised the skill of colour mixing powder paint, considering carefully how much water to paint powder we need and what to do if it was too thick or too runny. We went on to explore what happened when we added white to dark blue. The winter art the children created was a beautiful mix of blue tones.

January 26th marked the start of the 'Big Garden Bird Watch'. We talked to children about seeing birds in their garden and shared a tally chart for home enjoyment and participation. The children spent the next week exploring all about birds, creating birds through different forms such as painted or clay birds. We used our beautiful gardens again to 'bird watch' and we thought about what features a bird has and the names of the different birds we could find.



To finish off our half term, we plan to spend time enjoying the upcoming celebrations of Chinese New Year and Shrove Tuesday (Pancake Day). The children will be engaging in lots of cooking and arts to celebrate both occasions. We will use key stories to support our learning and we have learnt some fun rhythmic songs to complement each celebration. We will also have a visit from a local dentist and oral hygienist to discuss how to look after our teeth through brushing, making tooth friendly snack choices and making sure we change our toothbrushes every 3 months.

Safeguarding Procedures

To ensure that safety of all our children at school we would like to remind you about the importance we place on Safeguarding.

- Please ensure that you close all doors and gates behind you as you arrive and leave nursery.
- Please do not let other adults into the building always ask a member of staff to answer the door. If your child needs to use the toilet before their session starts please use the visitors toilet - we ask that
- parents do not enter the children's toilets.
- Always close the main black gate as you arrive and leave the site.
- Alert us if you see someone unfamiliar on the school site.
 - Please do not use your mobile phone whilst on the school grounds keep it in your pocket or bag as soon as you come through the gates on to the school site.
- Ensure that the appropriate age restrictions and parental controls are in place and that you monitor/supervise online content that your child watches whilst at home.
- If you are not going to be the person collecting your child from school, please let us know in advance - we will not allow any child to leave with an adult we do not know. The person collecting your child must be at least 18 years old.
- If you are running late to collect your child for any reason please ring the school office to let us know.
- If you see or hear anything whilst you are in nursery that concerns you please ask to speak to a Designated Safeguarding Lead, Julie, Clare or Suzie.
